PLEASE NOTE:

Riders: This is dress down dressage so there is no need to worry about squeezing into that show jacket or delving into the depths of that washing basket to dig out those cream breeches! Just turn up as you are in your comfiest clothes!

Horses/Ponies: Don't panic, a bath is not required, no horrendously early start for an insurmountable amount of flapping and no silly plaits! Make sure you make the most of your time out in the field the night before!

HOUSE KEEPING RULES:

We are so lucky to be able to use the wonderful facilities at Dallas Burston and we hope that you enjoy your day. Please read the following house keeping rules for the day which must be adhered to:

- **No Horses are to be tied up outside lorry/trailers with haynets**
- **No mucking out boxes into the lorry park**
- **ALL droppings MUST be picked up**
- **Children under the age of 16 MUST be supervised at ALL times**
- **Please read the competition T's & C's**

The Dressage League Points:

- Intro Tests are restricted to competitors with no BD points
- All other tests, in the spirit of fairness, combinations cannot enter a Prelim and Elementary, or Intro and Novice. This competition aims to encourage upward progression but in a fair way to all competitors.
- Western and bitless riders welcome in all classes.

General Rules, Terms & Conditions

1. The competition will be run under the rules of The British Riding Clubs effective 01 January 2018.
2. All competitors MUST have 3rd Party (Public Liability) insurance in place.
3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry, cancel a class, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor for any reason they deem necessary. Competitors failing to obey the instructions given by the Stewards, judges or other officials will be disqualified.
4. No entry fees will be refunded for withdrawals after the closing date unless a veterinary/medical certificate is presented. In any event £6 will be retained to cover administration costs.
5. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event at short notice in adverse ground or weather conditions. Entry fees, less £6 for administration, will be returned on receipt of SAE.
6. All horses and ponies to be four years and over.
7. Skull caps (PAS 015: 1998 or 2011, VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked, ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001/E2016 or AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked) must be worn, properly adjusted and fastened, at all times when mounted.
8. The organisers' decision is final.
9. Dogs are not allowed.
10. Young children must be supervised at all times.
11. Horses and ponies must not be left unattended in the lorry park unless secured correctly inside a trailer/horse box.
12. Please respect the hospitality of the Landowners and take your litter home. Do not clean out your horsebox.
13. HEALTH AND SAFETY: The Organisers for this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.
