SATURDAY 17th October 2020

Class 1	Open to Junior and senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Rider not to have completed a BE90, AE90, BRC HT90 or CH90 or above in the current competition year. Rider not to compete at 90 or above in qualifier or championship. Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any BE points. Not to have been placed in the top six at BE 80 or to have completed a BE 90 or above in the current or previous calendar year. Riders who have competed under FEI rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years, for the AE 70, AE 80, AE 90 applies to 2* and above only.
BRC Area 5 Mixed 70cm Arena Eventing Team and Individual Qualifier & Points Speed 340mpm	
Class 2	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any BE points Not to have been placed in the top six at BE 90 or to have completed a BE 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year. Riders who have competed under FEI rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years, for the AE 70, AE 80, AE 90 applies to 2* and above only.
BRC Area 5 Junior 80cm Arena Eventing Team and Individual Qualifier & Points Speed 350mpm	
Class 3	Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses may be registered with BE and have 1 BE point. All horses may be currently registered with BE but must not have been placed in the first six in any BE 100 or completed a BE105 or higher in the current or previous calendar year. Riders who have competed under FEI rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years, for the AE 70, AE 80, AE 90 applies to 2* and above only.
BRC Area 5 Junior 90cm Arena Eventing Team and Individual Qualifier & Points Speed 360mpm	
Class 4	Open to Junior and Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses may be registered with BE and have up to 20 BE points. Riders who have competed under FEI rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years, for the AE 100 this applies to 3* and above only
BRC Area 5 Mixed 100cm Arena Eventing Team and Individual Qualifier & Points Speed 375mpm	

SUNDAY 18th October 2020

Class 5	Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses may be registered with BE but must not have any BE points Not to have been placed in the top six at BE 90 or to have completed a BE 100 or above in the current or previous calendar year. Riders who have competed under FEI rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years, for the AE 70, AE 80, AE 90 applies to 2* and above only.
BRC Area 5 Senior 80cm Arena Eventing Team and Individual Qualifier & Points Speed 350mpm	
Class 6	Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses may be registered with BE and have 1 BE point. All horses may be currently registered with BE but must not have been placed in the first six in any BE 100 or completed a BE105 or higher in the current or previous calendar year. Riders who have competed under FEI rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years, for the AE 70, AE 80, AE 90 applies to 2* and above only.
BRC Area 5 Senior 90cm Arena Eventing Team and Individual Qualifier & Points Speed 360mpm	

The course will consist of a course of show jumps immediately followed by XC fences and will finish with the last fence as a show jump, the joker fence which will be set at a discretionary 10cm higher than the rest of the course. There will be a maximum of 20 jumping efforts, 9 SJ, 10 XC and the joker SJ fence. No horse may compete in more than one Arena Eventing class.

The time allowed will be based on 70cm – 340mpm, 80cm – 350mpm, 90cm – 360mpm, 100cm - 375mpm.

NO STOPWATCHES ALLOWED. Competitors are NOT allowed to take mobile phones onto the course when competing.

Entry Fee £ 35 per rider, all team members will automatically be entered as individuals.

Entry fee to include start fee.

- PLEASE NOTE ALL HORSES MUST BE MICROCHIPPED
- ALL HORSES MUST HAVE HAD A FLU VACCINATION WITHIN 6 MONTHS AND 21 DAYS OF THE COMPETITION AND NOT WITHIN THE 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EVENT (i.e. on or after 25th March 2020) A copy of the flu vaccination MUST be sent to Tony Parker BEFORE the event a5passports@gmail.com

HorseQuest Arena Eventing Championships to be held on 13 - 14 March 2021 Washbrook Farm, Aston-le-Walls, Daventry, Northamptonshire. NN11 6RT

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below: <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-rulebook>.

All entrants must pay a pre entry fee of £37 per team or £11 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries

www.britishridingclubs.org.uk or online entries can be made via the BRC website.

Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual (payable to BRC HQ), if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

Your horse must have up to date Influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook.

GENERAL RULES ALL CLASSES

Horse/ponies must be 4 years or older.

HAT STANDARDS All hats must have a visible AQUA BRC/ BE/PC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing. There will be a trained steward available on the day that will be carrying out hat tagging if your hat does not already have a tag.

BODY PROTECTORS: A body protector is obligatory in all cross-country competitions and is strongly recommended in show jumping competitions. A BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has been manufactured in the year 2009 or blue label 2018 must be worn. Body protectors should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer's instructions. The up to date BETA list of body protectors can be obtained from www.beta-uk.org.

If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector it must be worn over a permitted body protector and if activated, must be deflated or removed before continuing. Hybrid Air-jackets are permitted. Riders wearing Exo Body Cage (2000) protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

The uses of HEAD CAMS are strictly prohibited. This includes use on the head, chest, bridle or any other part of the horse or rider.

Medical armbands are strongly recommended and must be properly completed with the relevant competitor's details and worn on the arm.

Stop watches are NOT allowed.

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules found in the current version of the BRC rules. The full 2020 version is available to download online.

Each rider must print their own bib number.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A **SHORT** LEAD & CLEARED UP AFTER

OBJECTIONS:

Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary within half an hour of the incident together with a £50 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained. After this the score cannot be changed.

You will have an allotted time for your competitive round, please only arrive on site a maximum of 1 hour before your time and leave as promptly as possible afterwards, to ensure limited numbers on site at any time.

Please do not enter the warm up more than 30 minutes before your allotted time. Please ensure you bring an adequate supply of water for you and your horse.

Government guidelines could change quickly at any time; therefore Area 5 reserve the right to close site at short notice.
