Rider cannot have competed at BE novice or elementary dressage or above in the current or previous calendar year BD or BRC Horses may not compete in elementary DTM at the same qualifier or championship. Dressage to Music Mixed Pairs	7	Open to Senior and Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. For a pair of riders made up of any combination of senior and junior members. No BD points limit Test BRC Novice Pairs Dressage to Music (2018)	£22.00
Dressage to Music Pick a Test Medium/Advanced Medium Section (Qualifier)	8	Open to Senior and Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses in the Medium section may have unlimited Medium points, up to 35 total points at Adv. Medium or above. Test: BD Medium Freestyle to Music 2016	£15.00
	9	Open to Senior and Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses in the Adv. Medium section may have unlimited Adv. Medium points, up to 50 total points at Advanced or above. Test: Advanced Medium Freestyle to Music 2016

THIS EVENT IS BEING RUN UNDER BRITISH RIDING CLUB RULES 2023

All entrants must pay a pre entry of £20 per individual (£26 per pair) to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier online using the BRC entry system. <https://brc.bhs.org.uk/select>, Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £10 per individual if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sort.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

All hats must have a visible PINK BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website.

ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The judges/stewards should be treated with respect and their decisions are final. Anyone found to be rude or disrespectful to any official will be asked to leave the venue.
- No refunds will be made without a vet/doctor certificate, no refunds after close of entries.
- MMRC, the BHS, BRC and the land owners will not be held responsible for any loss, injury or accident to person, animal or property.
- Dogs must be on leads at all times and all fouling must be removed.
- The judge's decision and that of the BRC Official Steward is final. Any objections must be made in accordance with BRC rule G14I.

- On the day, Secretary and area 5 officials will be based in the Equine Reception room.
- Riders will not be admitted to the working-in arena without hats that are checked and tagged by the stewards.

HORSES

- NO HORSES TO BE TIED TO TRAILERS OR LORRIES UNLESS SUPERVISED. Horses that are known to get distressed when left in trailers/lorries MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES
- Day stables available on request £15 per box -arranged through the secretary
- NO hay nets to be tied outside of trailers or horseboxes.
- Please pick up any droppings your horse may leave behind tools and skip bucket can be found by the arena gate/doors.

MUSIC

- **All music is to be licensed and correctly labelled.** “You can use any music from the record labels listed on the Phonographic Performance Ltd (PPL) repertoire list. Tracks not listed cannot be used. Music that is not on the list can still be used but cannot be used alongside PPL listed music. It is the rider’s responsibility to ensure that the music they are using is correctly licensed before competing” **See BRC rule book for current rules on CD labelling.**
- All music is to be handed in to the secretary at least 1 hour prior to the scheduled time of the test.
- Competitors are covered under BRC music licence. Members do not need to join BD.
