Class 5	Junior Individual Intro – Intro C (2016) Up to 35 prelim points, 0 points at novice or above. FBHS, BHSI, BHSII gained in the last 10 years not allowed. Rider may not have competed at BE novice or Novice dressage in the current or previous calendar year BD or BRC. Horses may not have competed at novice or above in the current or previous competition year BD or BRC.
Class 6	Senior Prelim Team & Individual Dressage A) Prelim 2 (2016), B) Prelim 12 (2005), C) Prelim 14 (2006), D) Prelim 18 (2006) See eligibility criteria below
Class 6A	Senior Prelim Team and Individual – Prelim 2 (2016) Horses can have unlimited BD Prelim points but NO Novice pts. or above. Rider cannot have competed at Elementary or above in the same competition BD or BRC. Riders not to have FBHS, BHSI, BHSII in last 10 years, Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC
Class 6B	Senior Prelim Team and Individual– Prelim 12 (2005) Horses can have unlimited BD Prelim points but NO Novice pts. or above. Rider cannot have competed at Elementary or above in the same competition BD or BRC. Riders not to have FBHS, BHSI, BHSII in last 10 years, Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC
Class 6C	Senior Prelim Team and Individual – Prelim 14(2006) Horses can have unlimited BD Prelim points but NO Novice pts. or above. Rider cannot have competed at Elementary or above in the same competition BD or BRC. Riders not to have FBHS, BHSI, BHSII in last 10 years, Horses cannot have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC
Class 6D	Senior Prelim Team and Individual – Prelim 18 (2006) Horses can have unlimited BD Prelim points, up to 35 novice points but NO pts. at medium or above and must not have competed at Elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC.
Class 7	Senior Open Team Dressage A) Novice 24[2010], B) Novice 28[2008], C) Novice 34(2009), D) Elementary 44 [2002] See eligibility criteria below
Class 7A	Senior Team & Individual Novice Dressage NOVICE 24 (2010) Horses can have unlimited Novice points and up to 35 Elementary pts, NO Medium points or above

Class 7B	Senior Team & Individual Novice Dressage NOVICE 28 (2008) Horses can have unlimited Novice points and up to 35 Elementary pts, NO Medium points or above
Class 7C	Senior Team & Individual Novice Dressage NOVICE 34 (2009) Horses can have unlimited Novice points and up to 35 Elementary pts, NO Medium points or above
Class 7D	Senior Team & Individual Elementary Dressage ELEM 44 (2002) Horses can have unlimited BD Elementary points and up to 35 Medium points No Adv medium points or above
Class 8	Junior Team Dressage A) Prelim 7 (2002), Prelim 12(2005), Prelim 18(2006), Novice 24(2010) See eligibility criteria below
Class 8A	Junior Team & Individual Prelim Dressage PRELIM 7 (2002) Horses can have unlimited BD Prelim points, up to 35 novice points but NO pts at medium or above and must not have competed at Elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC.
Class 8B	Junior Team & Individual Prelim Dressage PRELIM 12 (2005) Horses can have unlimited BD Prelim points, up to 35 novice points but NO pts at medium or above and must not have competed at Elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC.
Class 8C	Junior Team & Individual Prelim Dressage PRELIM 18 (2006) Horses can have unlimited BD Prelim points, up to 35 novice points but NO pts at medium or above and must not have competed at Elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC.
Class 8D	Junior Team & Individual Novice Dressage NOVICE 24 (2010) Horses can have unlimited Novice points and up to 35 Elementary pts, NO Medium points or above
Class 9	Junior Elementary dressage ELEM 44 (2002) Horses can have unlimited BD Elementary points and up to 35 Medium points No Adv medium points or above

RESULTS: There will be no scoreboards on site, results will be published online after the competition. If you wish your test sheet /rosette to be returned to you please supply an A5 stamped addressed envelope with your competition number written on the back

No numbers will be provided, please use bridle or saddlecloth numbers visible on both sides of your horse or print off an A4 number and wear in a bib on your back.

Light refreshments will be available but no hot food.

COVID-19 precautions

Riders are permitted one helper per horse entered a non-riding Covid 19 declaration form will need to be completed for each helper so we have a record of people on site in the event that we need to provide track and trace details to the necessary authorities. We will not accept anyone just "turning up".

You must not attend site if you, or any of those travelling with you, or anyone from your household is exhibiting any symptoms of being unwell.

Social distancing of 1 metre plus must be strictly adhered to at all times.

No person is to access any other part of the site other than the car park and walking through the car park to the warm up area and arenas. The toilets in the main building will be closed to visitors.

No person should enter any other Lorry or car/trailer, or move close to any other rider, client, instructor, official or member of staff or any other member of the public at any time.

You will have an allotted time for your test, please only arrive on site a maximum of 1 hour before your time and leave as promptly as possible afterwards, to ensure limited numbers on site at any time.

Please do not enter the warm up area more than 30 minutes before your allotted time in order to warm up.

There will be minimal toilet facilities. Please ensure you bring an adequate supply of water for you and your horse.
