Pre-Entries

All entrants must pay a pre-entry per team, and per individual to British Riding Clubs by 9th October 2020.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of pre entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be considered from the original close of prelim entry date.

All hats must have a visible **AQUA** BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing.

Your horse must have up to date Influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is a checking device on the BRC website. **Passports must be emailed prior to the event to a5passports@gmail.com**

Tack and Dress Rules

Please make sure you adhere to tack and dress rules found in the current version of the BRC rules. The full 2020 Rulebook is available to download online.

General Rules

HATS must be worn whenever mounted and conform to PAS15 (1998 or 2011). VG01.040 2014-12. ASTM F1163.2004a and have a BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark, SNELL E2001 or 2016 (No additional mark required)

CORRECT dress & footwear must be worn.

ALL horses and ponies must be four years old and over.

ENTRIES accepted at rider's risk. SRC reserve the right to refuse an entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever. The Judge's decision is final.

INSURANCE Each competitor must carry their own liability insurance whether Riding Club, Pony Club, BHS, BS, BD, BE or independent cover.

HEALTH & SAFETY The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
