CLASS 1: KBIS JUNIOR 80cm WINTER INDOOR SHOWJUMPING - TEAM and INDIVIDUAL QUALIFIER (and points)

Teams consist of 3 or 4 riders with best 3 scores to count.

Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses cannot have competed at 90cm SJ or higher at National Championships in the same competition year. Horses may be currently registered with BE and have 1 BE point but must not have been placed in the first six in any BE 100 or completed BE105 or above in the current or previous calendar year at close of prelim entry. All points gained for double clears will not be counted

Max Height 80cm in first round, 85 cm 2nd round, 90cm J/O

CLASS 2: EQUI THEME JUNIOR 90cm SHOWJUMPING – TEAM and INDIVIDUAL QUALIFIER (and points)

Teams consist of 3 or 4 riders with best 3 scores to count.

Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club. Horses may have up to 500 BS points. 20 BE points.

Max height 90cm in the first round, 95cm 2nd round, 100cm J/O

CLASS 3: JUNIOR & SENIOR 100cm SHOWJUMPING – Team or Individual Qualifier & Points

Teams consist of 3 or 4 riders with best 3 scores to count.

Open to Junior & Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club. Horses may have 999 BS points. 60 BE points

Max height 100cm in the first round, 105cm 2nd round, 110cm J/O

CLASS 4: JUNIOR & SENIOR 110cm SHOWJUMPING – Team or Individual Qualifier & Points

Teams consist of 3 or 4 riders with best 3 scores to count.

Open to Junior & Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club. Horses may have unlimited BS and BE points.

Max height 110cm in the first round, 115cm 2nd round, 120cm J/O

PLEASE REMEMBER HORSES MAY ONLY COMPETE AT ONE HEIGHT

CLASS 5: KBIS SENIOR 80cm WINTER SHOW JUMPING - TEAM and INDIVIDUAL QUALIFIER (and points)

Teams consist of 3 or 4 riders with best 3 scores to count.

Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club that have paid their membership for the current year. Horses or ponies not to have won any BS points. Horses cannot have competed at 90cm SJ or higher at National Championships in the same competition year. Horses may be currently registered with BE and have 1 BE point but must not have been placed in the first six in any BE 100 or completed BE105 or above in the current or previous calendar year at close of prelim entry. All points gained for double clears will not be counted

Max Height 80cm in first round, 85 cm 2nd round, 90cm J/O

CLASS 6: EQUI THEME SENIOR 90cm SHOWJUMPING – TEAM and INDIVIDUAL QUALIFIER (and points)

Teams consist of 3 or 4 riders with best 3 scores to count.

Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club. . Horses may have up to 500 BS points. 20 BE points

Max height 90cm in the first round, 95cm 2nd round, 100cm J/O

DO NOT FORGET TO MAKE YOUR PRELIMINARY ENTRIES TO BRITISH RIDING CLUBS:

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Rule Book and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below: <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-rulebook>

All entrants must pay a prelim entry of £28 per team or £9 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries

www.britishridingclubs.org.uk or online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop www.britishhorse.com. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

All hats must have a visible **aqua** BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current rule book.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

- A full copy of vaccination certificate must be seen by the chief steward before the competition for each horse/pony's entry and the original must be produced on the day. Those in a qualifying place must NOT leave the showground before inspection of horse/pony and certificate by the Chief Steward.
- The Novice Indoor Show Jumping Championships will be held during the weekend of 30th & 31st March 2019 at Arena UK, Allington Lane, Allington, Grantham, NG32 2EF.
- The Intermediate Show Jumping Championships will be held during the weekend of 26th to 28th April 2019 at Bury Farm Equestrian Village.

CLOSING DATE: Friday 8th February 2019

NB: Entries received without payment will be rejected when entries close on Friday 8th February. Late entries may be refused if not received by the closing date So please make sure we have received your entry in order not to miss out.

RULES AND CONDITIONS.

1. Rules for Official Competitions 2019 with Area 5 amendments.
2. Protective head gear as specified in the BHS Riding Club "Rules for Official Competitions" 2019 must be worn by everyone mounted, whether competing or not. Failure to do so will incur elimination. The wearing of a back/body protector as specified in the BHS Riding Club "Rules for Official Competitions" 2019 is recommended for show jumping.
3. All Horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over.
4. Objections to be made in writing to the Organisers, accompanied by a deposit of £10, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
5. Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times.
6. Solihull Riding Club, its officers or anyone acting on their behalf shall not be held responsible for any accident, injury, loss or damage to or by horses, ponies, competitors, spectators or any persons, animals or property whatsoever.
7. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever.
8. No entrant shall be entitled to the return of any entry fee after closing date other than on production of the appropriate Veterinary or Medical Certificate and at the organisers' discretion.
